



Having created Eisugakkan in Hiroshima 1961, our founder, the late Tsutomu Kake, went on to establish various additional educational, social welfare, and medical institutions. In 1967, Tsutomu Kake acted to meet urgent needs by creating both Junsei Junior College and Junsei School of Nursing in Takahashi City, Okayama Prefecture. Subsequent expansion then occurred over the ensuing decades, resulting in the creation of one of the largest organizations of its kind in western Japan.

Mindful of its origins and the fact that its component institutions were each established in response to local community needs, Junsei Educational Institution has continuously striven to develop a distinctive private sector educational organization committed to the provision of high-quality teaching. Aiming throughout its history to maximize individual student potential and nurture good citizens at the local and international level, Junsei Educational Institution has long offered a wide range of comprehensive educational and training programs from undergraduate to doctoral level at its affiliated schools of Kibi International University, Kyushu University of Health and Welfare, Junsei School of Nursing and Welfare, and Institute of Health and Human Services of KUHW.



Founder
Tsutomu Kake

The founder Tsutomu Kake (1923-2008) stood in Hiroshima shortly after the war, and witnessed scenes of horror, in which there was nothing but burnt out ruins caused by the atomic bombing. In face of this tragedy, he determined that it was urgently needed to develop human resources through education to restore resource-deficient Japan and exploit ability of young people aiming for higher education to the fullest extent, and held up the ideal of "exploiting ability of each student to the fullest extent to cultivate human resources useful for society."

At the same time, he actively promoted international exchanges to make friends all over the world in order to prevent wars from occurring never again.

Bicchu Matsuyama Castle

The hill castle with the remaining castle tower built in 1683 is a national important cultural property.

The castle tower which exists at the summit of the Gagyusan mountain at an altitude of 430m stands at the highest altitude in Japan as a hill castle and it is also called as "Sky Hill Castle."



Raikyuji Temple

One of the Ankokuji temples built by order of Takauji Ashikaga. The garden created by Enshu Kobori in the early Edo period is designated as a national scenic spot.



Takahashi City Nariwa Museum

The exhibition focuses on the works of Torajiro Kojima, a western-style painter from Nariwa Town. The museum building designed by the world-famous Tadao Ando should not be missed.



A park where you can have various experiences on food and agriculture. We are affiliated to the park as a training site for our university and we participate in harvesting and exchanges.




Naruto Strait

Intensive Japanese Language Program, Kibi International University

Overview of Intensive Japanese Language Program

The Japanese Language Course of Kibi International University opened in April 2019 provides one-year course to teach Japanese language to foreign students who wish to enroll in one of the schools established by Junsei Educational Institution (Kibi International University, Kyushu University of Health and Welfare and Junsei School of Nursing and Welfare) but lack in Japanese language ability to understand lectures and practices in the universities and school and to deepen their understanding of Japanese culture.

Capacity

Admission capacity: 40 students

Term of study is one year.





Class content and completion requirements

Classes (lectures) are provided for five days from Monday to Friday over the two terms (spring term and autumn term) with 2 to 3 classes (1 class: 45 minutes x 2) daily.

[Classes are provided between 09:00 to 16:50, and the start time and finish time of the class vary depending on the day of the week.]

If a foreign student has been enrolled in the Japanese Language Course for minimum 1 year and acquired at least 46 credits from the class subjects listed in the table below, he/ she will be certified to have completed the course and given a certificate of completion.

School of Pharmaceutical Sciences

Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences (6-year)



The educational goal of the Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences is beyond passing the national pharmacist examination. Currently, due to sophistication of pharmacotherapy, pharmacists are gaining importance as an "expert in medicine" in team healthcare. In addition, current pharmacists are required to provide the best pharmacotherapy to doctors by conducting physical assessment of patients (to perform early discovery of effects or side effects of a medicine by actually touching the patient's body).

Students will acquire the abilities (knowledge, skills, thinking faculty and attitude) to produce people's happiness by enhancing the ability to think on their own over six years ranging from the basic subject after enrollment to the graduation research in the fifth and sixth year and through an appropriate and safe pharmacotherapy.

Key abilities to acquire

We train pharmacists who can read the patient's vital signs* through "bedside training" using sophisticated patient robots.

*Vital signs are basic biological information for judging whether life is at an imminent risk or not. Consciousness, pulse (heart rate), blood pressure, breathing, body temperature, etc.

Currently, as one of the national policies leading to "regional revitalization," development of industrial animals and food safety and related industries based thereon is required.

In this department, students do not only improve their ability to think on their own from the basic subjects after enrollment to the graduation research in the fourth year in order to acquire specialized knowledge to allow them to play an active part as an "animal nurse with knowledge of medicine," a "laboratory animal technician with knowledge of medicine," a "curator with knowledge on animals, medicines and foods" and a "food sanitation inspector or food sanitation supervisor," but also acquire the abilities (knowledge, skills, thinking faculty and attitude) to produce people's happiness.
